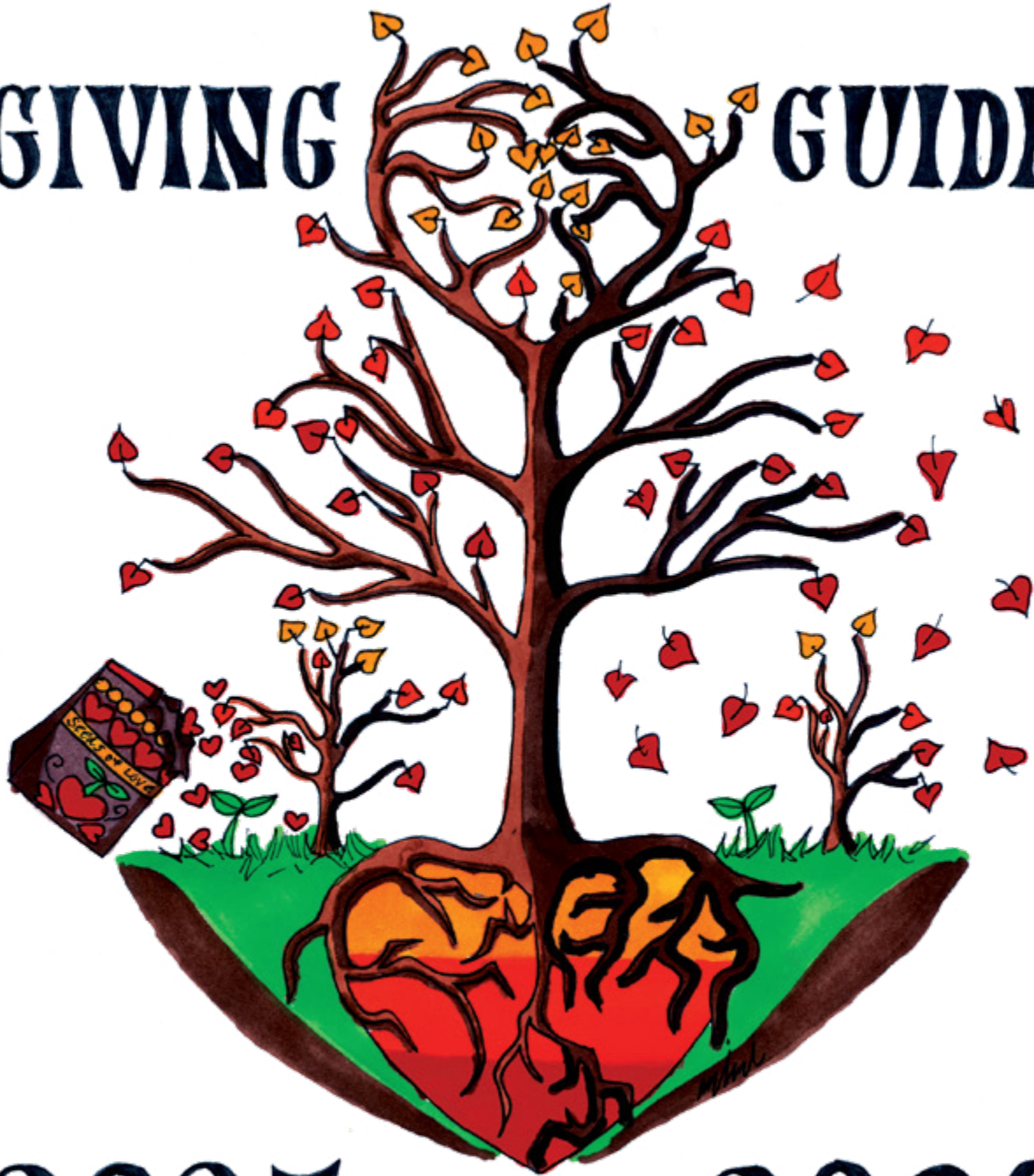

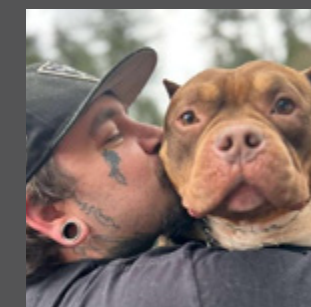

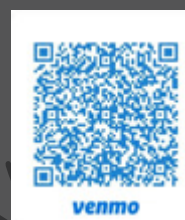

NEW SHELTERS OPEN

The Anchor Night-by-Night Shelter and West Shelter Village Tillamook County's first seven days a week, nightly shelter.

CARE Inc. helps people navigate the effects of poverty and offers basic needs, hope and programs taht get people back on their feet to become self-sufficient.

Due to the need in our community, CARE has built the first low barrier shelter in Tillamook County that will provide a safe place for people to rest their head at night. They can access services during the day and help to move forward thurgh through our navigation center with peer supports and housing case managers into permanent supportive housing.

The new shelters will help reduce crime, reduce costs that impact our Emergency Department and police calls. This makes Tillamook a safer place for all - everyone deserves a warm place to call home.

Meals for Seniors, Inc.

Our mission is to enable the senior citizens of North Tillamook County to continue living independently in their own homes by providing access to nutritious meals and social occasions.



OVERVIEW: There are senior citizens in our communities who do not know where their next meal is coming from; or who must make a choice whether to buy food or pay a medical bill. No senior should go to bed hungry. We can be there for these seniors, but only with your help.

Meals for Seniors, Inc. cooks, serves and delivers fresh, nutritious meals to senior citizens. We serve meals Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 11:30 am, 52 weeks of the year in the dining facility at St. Mary by the Sea Church in Rockaway Beach. Between Garibaldi and Nehalem, we also deliver meals to home bound seniors. For home bound seniors we deliver 6 meals per week, plus snacks – bringing both nourishment and a friendly visit. In 2025 alone we are on track to prepare over 18,500 meals!



NORTH COUNTY FOOD BANK



The North County Food Bank has provided food, clothing, and hygiene items to people and their pets for over 30 years. About 60 families depend on us every week, a big increase from last year.

What your donation supports:

- Tuesday weekly food/pet food distribution
- Friday Food Bag program at Neah-Kah-Nie High School/Middle School
- Little Free Pantries
- Access to fresh fruits and vegetables from Alder Creek Farm
- Child and adult diapers
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste, laundry soap, and other hygiene items
- Repository of information about local and national social service programs

North County Food Bank is committed to providing fresh food to our clients. We offer hamburger and chicken every week, as well as dairy products and produce. While we purchase some food from the Oregon Food Bank, much of the food we distribute comes from local stores.



The Food Bank is operating in temporary quarters supplied by the Nehalem Bay Health District after having to vacate our longtime location. Help us remodel this shop building to serve as a new permanent location for North County Food Bank.
